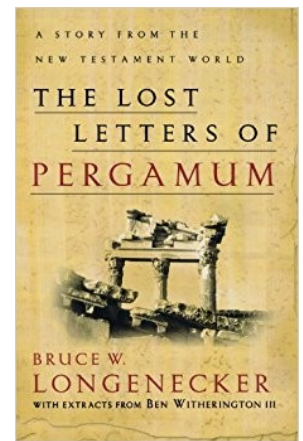
WEDNESDAY EVENING CLASS TO BREAK FOR BOOK DISCUSSION
