KidzWorship will not meet today.

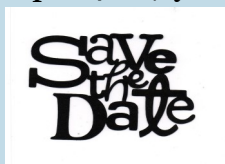

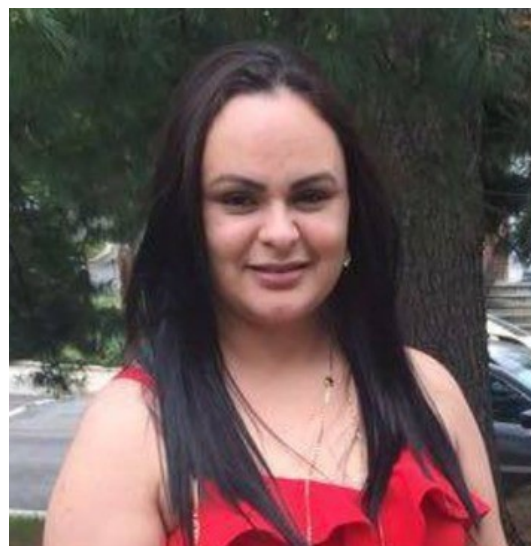
13TH ANNUAL A-SPAN WALK-A-THON ON OCTOBER 13, 2019
